Air Activities Stage 1

20th April : Join us as we learn to make 2 types of paper plane.

You'll need two pieces of paper (these can be scrap paper you've already drawn on and don't need). Before the meeting have a think about a time you might

have been on a plain or helicopter or seen one, where was it going? How did you feel? We'll be sharing our experiences.



27th April : Designing our own planes! What would yours include? A swimming pool perhaps?

Use whatever you have in your house, maybe lego, boxes, k'nex etc to make a model of your dream plain or helicopter before the meeting.

Think about a real plane or helicopter it might be similar to it could be a commercial aircraft like Concorde or Airbus or a military aircraft like a Spitfire, Lynx or Chinook. What does they have in common? Engine, emergency slides etc. We'll all show everyone what we've made and describe it. Think about why would you like to fly in it?

4th May : The Phonetic Alphabet

The leaders will help you learn how to say your name in the phonetic alphabet, afterwards practice at home and we'll ask you next week!

11th May : What is a map?

The leaders will show you a photo map of the Manor, can you find our HQ?

What other interesting things can you see on it? Can you see your school? We'll also be asking you to spell your name in the phonetic alphabet.

18th May : Four compass points

What are the four points? How do you know which way is which?
